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East Bay K – 8 School * School Advisory Council * February 11, 2022

Alison Keegan called the meeting to order at 7:35 a.m.

In attendance were council members Principal, Beth Mosley, Assistant Principal, Trish Johnson, Alison Keegan, Jen Sevilla, Rebecca Webster, Amy Chamberlin, Gretchen Clarke, Leah Cortello, Dana McKnight, Ann-Marie McNabb, Amanda Morgan, Tiffany Spooner.

Also in attendance was parent, Erik McNabb.

An agenda, Star C report and last meeting's minutes were provided.

Gretchen Clarke made a motion to approve the 11/16/21 meeting minutes; Tiffany Spooner seconded; motion passed; minutes were approved.

Beth Mosley reported on our current enrollment of 974, with a capacity of 1200; projection for next school year is 1000 students. Discussion regarding "out of zone" transfer requests followed. Mrs. Mosley also reported a staffing plan with the projected 1,000 would result in an additional secretary.

East Bay playground (2) deliveries will begin on Feb. 21st. There will be an organized scheduling of playground time between the classes.

Unused Title I funds were recently retrieved by the district, due to East Bay's free and reduced percentage falling below the 40% requirement. All but ~\$1500 were spent, the district has absorbed the cost of previous expenditures.

Coupon Books fundraiser will begin Feb. 18th – March 7th. Regular Coupon and Taste of Excellence books are \$20/each.

Navarre High School officials will be holding an orientation for our 8th graders, here at East Bay, on April 11th.

The Star C report was discussed; we are on the path to earning "A" school status.

Anne-Marie McNabb introduced 2 concerns to the council; (1) afternoon car rider cars entering the property while students are still at recess or involved in a fire drill, (2) there are some bathrooms in classrooms that do not have locks; Mrs. Mosley is investigating.

Gretchen Clarke voiced a concern with the cafeteria menus being sent home differing from what is being served. Visitor, Mr. McNabb voiced concern with the middle school students eating lunch with the elementary students. The schedule for next year is being reviewed and every possible effort will be made to improve the lunch cycles between elementary & middle school.

A second-grade teacher for Mrs. Pickert's vacancy has been hired and will start on February 28th.

Field day will be on March 11th; Kona Ice will be available.

Mrs. Mosley will be meeting with grade levels to discuss schedule change options for next year.

With no further comments or questions, meeting adjourned by Alison Keegan at 8:36 a.m.
