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### **East Bay K – 8 School \* School Advisory Council \* November 16, 2021**

Alison Keegan called the meeting to order at 7:35 a.m.

In attendance were Principal, Beth Mosley, Assistant Principal, Trish Johnson, Alison Keegan, Jen Sevilla, Rebecca Webster, Debbie Stanhagen, Amy Chamberlin, Gretchen Clarke, Ann-Marie McNabb, Amanda Morgan, Lindsey Polk & Tiffany Spooner.

A meeting agenda, Student Performance Data report, the pending 2021-22 Operating budget, and a copy of last meeting's minutes were provided to all.

Tiffany Spooner made a motion to approve the 9/9/21 meeting minutes; Ann-Marie McNabb seconded; motion passed; minutes were approved.

Alison Keegan reported the SAC approved SIP was accepted by the school district. With SAC input, the Parent & Family Engagement Plan was drafted and submitted to the Federal Programs department by Trish Johnson, copies were made available to the council.

Beth Mosley reported on the current school enrollment of 970 students. In addition, Mrs. Mosely reported on the success of the school-wide Boosterthon fundraiser, with a net profit of ~\$38,000 to be spent on technology and instructional resources.

Mrs. Mosley referenced the Student Performance Data report that was provided to all, discussing, in detail, the 2021 Spring FSA data from our feeder schools, and East Bay's current data from the Fall Star Tests A & B.

Mrs. Mosley reported on her concrete goal of an FSA/EOC proficiency of 75%, with learning gains across the board and among the lowest 25%. Also, she explained the importance of elementary math, specifically, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades, as it pertains to students possessing the ability to perform in the advanced math classes through middle school, culminating with Algebra I in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. The caveat being student readiness and realistic expectations of each student.

Mrs. Mosley informed members of Morgan Evans being selected as East Bay's Teacher of the Year and her ITV class' participation and winning the Promethean Classroom Stories competition. The class will receive a Promethean ActivPanel Titanium™, including ActivInspire® and ClassFlow® software, a fixed-mobile

stand, a Promethean Chromebox, and professional development training through Learn Promethean.

Trish Johnson provided a safety report to members; emphasizing the successful lockdown drill, the “No Parking” signs on Elkhart where our walkers are crossing the street and Deputy Psinas is directing traffic. Also, Mrs. Johnson reported on the banning of football at recess to prevent injuries.

The expected playground equipment delivery and installation has been delayed; estimated arrival is to be determined.

Mrs. Mosley discussed the upcoming events in December, which include *The Joy of Giving* and the *Jingle Jog*.

Mrs. Mosley introduced discussion of the school's 21-22 Operating Budget and asked Debbie Stanhagen to expound on the allocations. Amy Chamberlin made a motion to approve the operating budget for 2021-22, Amanda Morgan seconded; motion passed, budget was approved.

Mrs. Mosley solicited input regarding a spring fundraiser; the members were in agreement of the need; selling coupon books was discussed.
